I make this affidavit voluntarily and from my own personal knowledge for the purpose of complying with the requirement of Government Code Chapter 614 Peace Officers and Fire Fighters, Subchapter "B". "Complaint against Law Enforcement Officer or Fire Fighter", that in order that a complaint against a Law Enforcement Officer of the State of Texas or against a fireman or policeman may be considered by the Chief of head of the department involved, the complaint must be placed in writing and signed by the person making the complaint. By law the accused is entitled to a copy of this complaint affidavit.

SECTION 37.02, PERJURY. THE TEXAS PENAL CODE OF 1973:

(a) A person commits an offense if, with the intent to deceive and with knowledge of the statement's meaning:

- (1) he makes a false statement under oath or swears to the truth of a false statement previously made; and
- (2) the statement is required or authorized by law to be made under oath.

(b) An offense under this Section is a Class A misdemeanor. "(Punishment for Class A misdemeanor: A fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or a jail term of not more than one (1) year, or both such fine and imprisonment)

I have read Section 37.02 of the Texas Penal Code of 1973, as set out above, and I am aware of the penalty set out therein for perjury.

I have read all of the above affidavit, including the printed, typewritten and handwritten portions thereof, and the statements therein are true.
