

Lake Ridge High School School Attendance Options

Incoming juniors and seniors (**and their siblings who attend the same high school**) in the new Lake Ridge attendance zone have the option of staying at their current school until they graduate.

There will be open enrollment for Lake Ridge High School. It will be called the Lake Ridge Option. Any incoming 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grader in MISD may transfer to Lake Ridge High School. **Applications for the Lake Ridge Option are due in the Director of Campus Support office by January 23, 2012.**

Once a Lake Ridge Option transfer has been approved, these students will stay at Lake Ridge until they graduate as long as they meet the following requirements in the 2012-2013 school year:

Students must have 90% or better attendance.

Students must pass the four core courses: English, science, math, social studies.

Students must be promoted to the next grade level.

Failure to meet these standards may result in the transfer being revoked.

The Director of Campus Support may revoke a student's transfer to Lake Ridge High School for disciplinary reasons (effective at the end of the 2012-2013 school year).

The District will not provide transportation for students using the Lake Ridge Option.

Students using the Lake Ridge Option may apply to return to their home campus through the Director of Campus Support.
