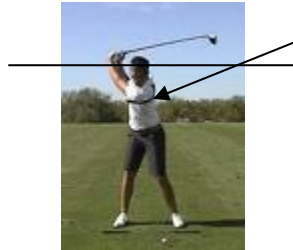
## Coaches Corner

**More Power**

The key to more power is in the shoulders. When trying to get an extra 10 yards off the tee try relaxing your grip and making a bigger shoulder turn. Most players tend to tighten up thus reducing flexibility. So keep a solid base and rotate

your forward shoulder as far under your chin as possible.



Also, notice that the club does not need to go past parallel. Now release the club head down the line and let it FLY!!!

## Unplayable Lie— What do I do?

You and you alone are the judge as to whether your ball is unplayable (yes – you could declare an unplayable lie in the middle of the fairway). Once you have identified your ball and decided to declare your ball unplayable, you have three options.

**Option 1** – Take two club lengths relief from the ball no closer to the hole.

**Option 2** – Replay the shot from the original position. One stroke penalty

**Option 3** – Take the ball back as far as you want keeping the point where the ball lays between you and the hole. One stroke penalty
