Wrong Ball—Rule 15

First, you must be able to identify your ball as yours and yours alone! Put some kind of ID on the ball so you can clearly see from BOTH sides that the ball belongs to you! If you do strike a wrong ball, the mistake must be corrected before you tee off on the next hole. You must go back and find your ball and finish the hole with it. No strokes count taken with a WB. But, you do have two strokes added to the hole for playing a WB. What happens if you don't correct your mistake before teeing off the next hole? DISQUALIFICATION----OUCH!
