**The Bus Transportation Facility included in the bond proposal will be a facility to park additional buses. The core Transportation Administrative Offices will remain at the MISD Operations Complex at Highway 1187 and Main Street in Mansfield.

Tax Impact

An Interest and Sinking (I&S) tax rate increase from \$0.395 in 2006-07 to a peak of \$0.45 in 2009-10. This tax increase is approximately \$0.055 per \$100 property valuation or about a total of \$55.00 over a four (4) year period for an assessed evaluation of \$100,000.00.

Note: If the District is approved for additional Existing Debt Allotment Funding, the total tax impact could be as low as 3 cents per \$100 property valuation over three years.
