Course Information

Poetry in Motion

Becoming a writer involves evoking all the senses and bringing experiences to life in a meaningful way. This writing course will use music, photography, and basic yoga poses to improve concentration, develop visual memory, and enhance creativity. Campers will create a published work of fiction or nonfiction using technology and multimedia processes.

Discover Engineering

Campers will experience engineering through hands-on, creative investigations and building activities. The goal of the camp is not only to show what engineering is all about but also to expose them to the fact that “engineers’ work” is all around them. Discover Engineering opens a pathway for girls and boys from all backgrounds that is based on their curiosity about the way things work.

Discover Russia on 20 Words a Day!

In Dance, students will learn today’s hottest dance moves and some of the best from the past. In Memories, students will bring in their favorite photos to make into a memory book to keep, a few pages will be left blank at the end to add in new memories!

CSI: Ben Barber

In CSI: Ben Barber, students will learn what roles law enforcement, court procedure and corrections play in American justice all while learning techniques such as fingerprinting, crime scene photography, crime scene search Driving While Intoxicated simulation, handcuffing and much more. Come see what all the excitement in the Law/Public Safety field is all about!

Hip Hop Poetry

This class will analyze the poetry of Hip-Hop and compare its motifs, themes, and general poetic devices to the “classic” poems. traditionally studied in order to teach the core elements of the poetic craft in an appealing, and relevant manner.

Online Learning and Virtual Worlds

Campers will be introduced to Online Learning and Virtual 3-D Worlds. They will learn how to work independently and in cooperative groups. The class will be set up as if it was online. Campers will participate in quests that will increase their language and problem solving skills, and their ability to collaborate . They will showcase their electronic journal and portfolio the last day of camp.

Culinary Arts

Culinary Basics and Beyond! Students will work hands on with professional chefs in a commercial kitchen learning cooking and baking techniques as well as preparing delicious recipes. (Closed toe shoes and long pants required)

Let’s Play

Participants will be working cooperatively to write and produce their own skits. Students will be actively involved in every aspect of the planning and will be responsible for creating their own scenery, costumes and props. Friends and family will be invited to attend the final performance on the last day of camp.

Radio Camp

In Radio Camp, students will have the opportunity to learn to write, record and edit their own radio commercial. The second week of camp the students will incorporate their commercial into a live radio show over the airwaves of 99.9 The Wild. Students will receive a CD copy of both their show and the commercials at the end of camp.

Video Camp

In Video Camp, students will spend one week working in Ben Barber’s television studio on their very own newscast or talk show; run cameras, teleprompters, audio, control board or be on camera talent! During the second week, student will spend time in “field production” making their very own video. Students will learn camera techniques and computerized editing so they can walk away with their very own video.

Introduction to Digital Photography and Editing

Students will learn the basic operations of a camera and camera basic Photoshop and printing techniques Students must supply their own digital camera. Students will have a gallery exhibit for their work on the last day of camp.

Introduction to Floral Design

Campers will learn how to design and arrange flowers with step by step methods and hands-on training in: Principles of design, color, bows, corsages and boutonnieres, one and 3 bloom bud vases, circular arrangements, bouquets and holiday arrangements. There will be a gallery showing of their work before they take it home.

Tell Me a Story!

Creative writing and storytelling encourages imagination. Campers will learn a fun love for the written word and foster the joy of reading. Campers will free write, analyze and critique writing samples, and collaboratively write to produce a manuscript to present in a creative writing contest. Campers will learn the craft of storytelling by listening to stories and creating their own to be showcased on the last day. They will dress in character to bring excitement and life to their creation.
