

Practice What You Learned in the Tutorial!

Back to Basics StarOffice Impress 8.3 (Multimedia)

Scenario/Purpose: You want to create a short, 3-slide 'beginning of class' presentation (slide show) that students will see when they enter your classroom each day. You want to convey today's topic lesson, objectives, and end the presentation with a "hook" that will get students interested in the lesson.

Instructions:

- Using StarOffice Impress (version 8.0 or 8.3) select a presentation background from step #2 of the Presentation Wizard. Select a transition from step #3 of the Presentation Wizard.
- Create a 3-slide presentation...

Slide requirements:

- Slide 1 (topic slide):
 - Center your topic on the slide. Use a 48 point Arial font. Bold it.
 - Insert an appropriate graphic from the gallery.
- Slide 2 (lesson objective slide):
 - Select the "Title, Text, Clipart" layout from the Layout List.
 - List your lesson objectives.
 - Insert a graphic from a file (You probably have graphics in the 'My Pictures' folder that's inside the 'My Documents' folder.)
- Slide 3 (create a hook)
 - Select a layout of your choice from the Layout List.
 - Insert a graphic from the gallery or from a file.
