AFFIDAVIT FOR PROOF OF RESIDENCY GUIDELINES

2006-07 School Year

Affidavits may be approved by the Superintendent or designee, which will assist in maintaining a balanced enrollment among the District's campuses. An official Affidavit application for such enrollment must be submitted annually. This application must be signed by the MISD resident.

The affidavit must be submitted to the student's campus of attendance. Please contact the campus if further information is needed.

All affidavits will be reviewed and may be accepted using the following criteria:

- Completion of MISD Affidavit for Proof of Residency, obtained at the campus.
- Affidavit signed.

It is a criminal offense under Penal Code 37.10 to present false information or records for identification. Enrolling a child under false documents makes the person liable for the maximum tuition fee the District may charge or the amount the District has budgeted per student as maintenance and operating expense, whichever is greater (Education Code 25.001 (h)).

Presenting false information on an Affidavit for Proof of Residency application or failing to update the information presented in a timely manner shall be considered sufficient grounds for revocation of any enrollment.
