<u>MISD Test Date:</u>	Saturday, October 15, 2005
<u>Test Site:</u>	The Student's MISD High School Home Campus
<u>Who should test?</u>	Juniors & Sophomores
<u>Test Registration:</u>	Registration begins at each high school home campus on September 19 th , 2005. Check with the high school counseling center for details.
<u>Test Fee:</u>	\$18 Cash or Money Order (September 19-October 6) \$23 Cash or Money Order (after October 6 th)
<u>Test Content:</u>	2 Critical Reading Sections (25 minutes each) 2 Math Sections (25 minutes each) 1 Writing Skills Section (30 minutes)
<u>Testing Duration:</u>	Approximately 3 hours
<u>Arrival Time On Test Day</u>	7:45 a.m. Testing will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. (No late entries after testing begins)
