STUDENT ACCOUNT INFORMATION

Student Accounts

- *Parents are responsible for maintaining funds in their child's account.*
 - *MISD Student Nutrition will send low balance envelopes home for PK-4th grade in the student's folder when balance goes below \$5.00.*
 - *5th – 12th grade will receive verbal low balance notification when balance goes below \$5.00*

Student Accounts

- *Parents who have applied for benefits under the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program are responsible for any charges incurred prior to the approval of benefits.*
- *Parents with computer access may receive email low balance notification through "Parent Online" (See the link on our webpage).*

Student Accounts

- Should a student reach a zero balance, they will be allowed to charge regular lunch meals up to a maximum of (-\$5.00). No ala cart items, breakfasts or high school extreme meals may be charged. When the maximum has been reached the student will be offered an alternative meal. Alternative meals will not be offered at breakfast.*

Student Accounts

- The alternative meal is a cheese sandwich and a carton of white milk*
- Students may receive an alternative meal for a maximum of 3 days*
- After three days students will no longer receive meals from the cafeteria until outstanding charges are paid.*



Student Accounts

- *Accounts that are not paid in full will go onto the MISD Fine Notification System*
