LHS Driver Education Program

State law requires thirty-two (32) hours of classroom instruction, seven (7) hours of behind the wheel driving, and seven (7) hours of in-car observation. The student must be at least 15 years of age on or before the class begins. The driving portion of the program will be concurrent with the classroom or until all students have obtained their certificates. To be eligible to receive an instructional permit, the student must have an original, certified birth certificate (**hospital certificates are NOT acceptable**) and an original social security card. Both of these documents must be presented to the DPS when applying for a permit.

Enrollment Process

- Applications must be **complete** before being considered.
- Students will be notified upon acceptance to the program.
- The final balance is due no later than the first day of class.

Withdrawal Policies

- A student may be removed from class:
 - 1- if requested by parents,
 - 2- for excessive "unexcused" absences, or
 - 3- for discipline problems.
- A student who is removed from the class **will not** receive a refund.

Class Information

- Classes will be held at Legacy High School.
- 20 students must be registered for class to be held (maximum number of 30).
- Students are accepted on a first come-first serve basis.
- The age of the applicant may be considered when class assignments are being made.

Cost/Payment Procedures

- The fee to participate in the LHS Driver Education Program is \$265.00. Students will be notified upon their acceptance into the program. An additional \$5.00 fee will be collected by DPS at the time of the student's written permit test.
- Payment is due on the specified day given on the acceptance letter and a receipt will be issued. Money orders will be accepted for all fees and should be made payable to: **MISD Driver Education. No cash or checks will be accepted.**
- Students must cancel behind-the-wheel driving / observation sessions at least 24-hours in advance or they will be charged a \$20.00 per no-show occurrence.
- Extra driving lessons may be requested at a cost of \$20.00 per lesson.
- A student failing the driving test must pay \$10.00 for each additional test.
- Copies / duplications of DrEd Certificates of Completion will cost \$5.00 each.

Tentative Summer Class Schedules: Please circle two class dates you could attend and rank as your first (1) and second (2) choices. Once a class is filled, the remaining student applicants will be offered the next available date.

- **June 9 – July 1 (9:00-11:00)**
- **July 14 – August 5 (9:00-11:00)**

Required Signatures: Parental assistance serves to complement both class and the practice-driving portions of Driver Education. Parents need to encourage students to study and drive at home while taking the course in school and after its completion. The parents' role is one of reinforcing skills introduced by the Driver Education instructor. For every hour of driving time scheduled at school, the student should have a minimum of four hours of driving time at home. We believe that much more time is required for your child to become a competent driver. Individual Driving Instruction - MISD Driver Education attempts to schedule two students for every two hour in-car lesson. However, in the event that one student fails to report at the scheduled appointment time, it may become necessary for a student to drive alone with an instructor. By signing this document you give permission for your child to participate in the MISD Driver Education class and in-car practice sessions and agree to support said student with required course work and practice-driving at home. A student's signature demonstrates an agreement to comply with course requirements.
