Parents and Students:

Attached is the list of Bluebonnet nominated books for 2007-08. The Bluebonnet book program is a reading incentive program in the state of Texas. It is designed for students in grades 3-6, and is completely voluntary. Students who read 5 or more Bluebonnet nominated books by January 6, 2008 will be eligible to vote for their favorite Bluebonnet book in the state Bluebonnet election held in January 2008. Students who read 10 or more Bluebonnet nominated books will receive some special recognition at the end of the year.

Many of your students may have started reading the Bluebonnets over the summer – keep reading! Our library at Daulton has a number of the books on this year's Bluebonnet list, and those not available at Daulton are available from the Mansfield or Grand Prairie Public Library.

To help you track the Bluebonnets your child has read, I have attached a check off sheet. These sheets will be turned in to your child's classroom teacher in January (to determine eligibility to vote in the state Bluebonnet election), and again in April (to determine the total number of Bluebonnets your student has read throughout the year).

This year's Bluebonnet list contains many wonderful books of different genres. Please help and encourage your child to become a Daulton Bluebonnet reader!
