SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY (Voted on May 2006, implemented August 2006)

- The site based committee and staff were surveyed and in favor of soliciting the vote.
- Parents were surveyed and 100% responded. The outcome was overwhelmingly in favor of a standardized dress (80%) for Glenn Harmon students.

SHIRTS:

Must have a collar

Style: polo, oxford (buttons down the front), turtleneck

Color: red, navy, white, black, light blue, khaki—all solids, no stripes or plaids

Sleeves: long or short but must have sleeves

Plain: no logos or printing

TEE SHIRTS:

Only Glenn Harmon spirit wear tees will be allowed.

PANTS, SHORTS, SKORTS, SKIRTS, JUMPERS, CAPRIS:

Must not be baggy or saggy

Color: navy, black, khaki

Style of pants and shorts: "docker style"

Boys' shorts should not be below the knee

Girls' shorts should be a minimum of ½ distance between fingertips and top of the

Knee when the student's hand is fully extended down the side of the leg

Pants may not be worn below the hipbone

No "cargo" pants, knit or "wind" pants

SWEATSHIRTS AND SWEATERS:

Plain—no logos or printing except Glenn Harmon spiritwear

Color: red, navy, white, black, light blue, khaki—all solids

If a shirt is worn under the sweatshirt, the collar needs to be out

COATS AND OUTERWEAR:

Must be hung in the locker. Coats may not be worn in class or to an assembly.

SHOES:

Basic athletic shoes, tennis shoes or closed-toe shoes such as a loafer
Must be worn with socks or anklets

BELTS:

Belts are required if the shirt is tucked in. Students **will not** be required to tuck the shirt tail if the shirt is of the appropriate size and fit with a finished hemline.

SPIRIT DAYS or "FREE DRESS DAYS":

Will be determined by the uniform committee
