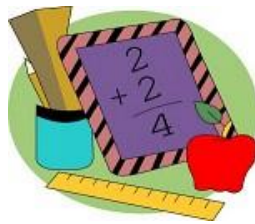


SECOND GRADE NEWS

Second Grade Colts will continue to enjoy working and learning. The following is what your child will be learning in second grade the second six weeks.



In Language Arts, we will continue to read fiction and non-fiction while we build comprehension strategies. Please encourage your child to read at least one hundred minutes every week for pleasure. Have your child choose books to read on topics that interest him/her. Please ask your child's teacher if your child needs to bring books home to read from school. We want our Colts to establish a love for reading.



In Mathematics, students will write, compare and order numbers to 100. Coins will also be identified and represented in different combinations using coins and bills to show the same amounts of money. In order to get away from using fingers to count,

we will be working on mental strategies to add and subtract. Please remind your child to study addition and subtraction math facts.



In Social Studies, students will locate our community, state, country, and continent on maps and globes. Landforms and bodies of water will be described, identified, and located on maps. We will also discuss how nature affects how we live.



In Science, your child is going to experiment with the laws of force and motion. We will discover how gravity and friction affect motion.
