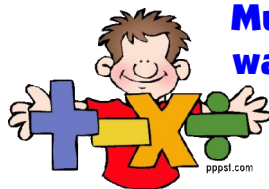

Math Mania



Multiplication and division have an inverse relationship. Two other ways to think about division are sharing and repeated subtraction. Here are some vocabulary words your child should learn: dividend, divisor, and quotient.



LANGUAGE LABORATORY

A homograph is one of two or more words that are spelled alike but have different meanings. The words may be pronounced alike or differently. Example- The little girl had a pretty red bow in her hair. The children took a bow after the program. The young Indian chief carried a special bow and arrow. A homophone is one of two or more words that are pronounced alike but have different meanings and may possible be spelled differently. Examples: too, to, two.
