TEXAS PTA PARENT EDUCATION PROGRAMMING AWARD

PURPOSE OF AWARD

The Texas PTA Parent Education Programming Award encourages participation of Local and Council PTAs in parent education programs.

CRITERIA FOR RECOGNITION

This form shall be used for Local and Council entries. **Note:** Area PTA workshops, Officers' and Chairmen's Training, Texas PTA Leader Orientations and Local PTA meetings are not considered for recognition. The time spent for the PTA business meeting and other types of programs or presentations must not be included when calculating the three hours of parent education. Please include the following information within your narrative- parent education goals adopted and achieved, strategies used to increase attendance and results, and evaluation methods used and results.

BRONZE LEVEL AWARD - Each of the following requirements must be met to receive the **Bronze Level** award.

1. At least one (1) parent education topic presented during a local or council PTA meeting or other designated parent education night. (Informational brochure should be included with entry)

SILVER LEVEL AWARD - To achieve a **Silver Level** Award complete all of the Bronze Level requirements plus the following:

2. Six (6) hours of Parent Education/Programming Workshops attended by a member of your local or council PTA during Summer Seminar, Texas PTA State Convention or National PTA Convention. (Copy of registration sheet with workshops listed should be included with entry)

3. At least one parent education brochure/flyer distributed to membership during your general meeting or to entire student body included with entry.

4. Another parent education topic, for two (2) total- presented during a local or council PTA meeting or other designated parent education night. (Informational brochure should be included with entry)

GOLD LEVEL AWARD - To achieve a **Gold Level** Award complete all of the above Bronze and Silver Level requirements plus the following:

5. Another six (6) hours, for twelve hours total, of Parent Education/Programming Workshops attended by a member of your local or council PTA during Summer Seminar, Texas PTA State Convention or National PTA Convention. (Copy of registration sheet with workshops listed should be included with entry)

6. At least one multi school presentation for parent education/programs. (Informational brochure should be included with entry)
