The MISD Education Foundation has awarded Worley Middle School with a grant, which will give all 7<sup>th</sup> grade students the opportunity to participate in a book study through the Advisory class, during the month of May, of the #1 New York Times best-seller, *Three Cups of Tea – Young Readers Edition* by Greg Mortenson.



The book recounts the author's journey as he finds himself lost and injured while trying to climb K2, the second highest mountain in the world. He eventually wanders into the village of Korphe, and the villagers there take him in and nurse him back to health. As he heals, he begins to notice that the children are writing with sticks in the dirt and have little-to-no educational resources. Before leaving, he makes a promise to return one day and build a school for the children. After much persistence, the author is finally able to honor his promise to the Korphe village by returning and building a school. He eventually spends over a decade building more than sixty schools throughout Pakistan and Afghanistan in an effort to promote literacy world-wide.

The book is designed to broaden students' cultural horizons, while also teaching them about the value of education.

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
