## **Summer School Program**

### **Purpose**

Summer school at MISD is for **credit recovery only**, meaning that students with absence-fails and/or students who earned grades below 70 may attend. Students may enroll in one ½ credit course at a time. If a student finishes one course, he/she may register for a second course if enough days remain in the summer session to finish the second course.

### **Schedule**

MISD's High School Summer School Program will be held at Summit High School, 1071 West Turner Warnell Rd. Arlington, TX 76001, beginning Monday, June 5 and concluding Thursday, June 29 from 7:30 until 12:30 **Monday through Thursday. No Friday Classes!**

### **Enrollment**

Registration forms may be picked up in the high school counseling center at Mansfield High School, Summit High School, and Timberview High School.

- Completed application forms must be turned in to the Counseling Center for approval. The student's counselor **must** sign the enrollment form.
- Applications must be complete and full payment must be received prior to enrollment in the program.

### **Tuition**

Tuition is \$135 per one-half credit course for students attending an MISD high school or \$195 for students who do not attend an MISD high school but their parent resides in the MISD attendance zone. Payment of tuition is due by **Friday, June 2, 2006** so that we may provide appropriate staffing. **Cash or money orders will be accepted for all fees, but no checks will be accepted.** All registration forms and fees must be given to the bookkeeper and a receipt will be issued. Please keep this receipt.

### **Attendance**

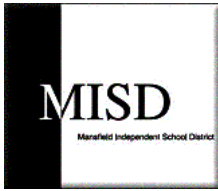
**Attendance is a critical requirement** of this intensive summer school program with **one day** equaling approximately **one week** in the long term. Students will be withdrawn for excessive tardies and/or absences. Two or more excused absences is considered excessive and three or more excused tardies is considered excessive. A student is considered absent if more than twenty minutes late to class. Each student must attend from 7:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday until the entire coursework is completed and a grade of 70 or above is achieved.

### **Code of Conduct**

Students must adhere to the Mansfield ISD student code of conduct with the understanding that they may be removed from the program for disciplinary infractions, forfeiting their registration fee.

### **Transportation**

Students are required to secure transportation both to and from school daily. No bus transportation is provided for summer school. Please make transportation arrangements before coming to school.
