## / How to Keep Your School Device Safe and Secure

Using a digital device like a computer or tablet can make learning easy and fun. It's like having an entire library in your book bag. Since you will be using your device to do most of your school work, it is important that you take proper care of it. Here are the top tips to make sure your device is not damaged, lost or stolen:

1. KEEP YOUR DEVICE OUT OF SIGHT

When you're not in the classroom, keep your device in your book bag or somewhere out of sight. If you store the device in your locker, make sure the door is locked.

2. DON'T TELL OTHERS THAT YOU HAVE A DEVICE

If you are allowed to take your device home, don't advertise to others you have a device.

- NEVER LEAVE YOUR DEVICE UNATTENDED Don't leave your device unattended at school or in public, even to use the bathroom. Just because
  - in public, even to use the bathroom. Just because it's out of sight in your book bag doesn't mean it's safe. A thief only needs a few seconds to steal your device.
- 4. DON'T LEND YOUR DEVICE TO ANYONE

Never loan your device to anyone without permission from a teacher or school administrator. Other people may not treat the device with the same care and respect as you do.

5. DON'T USE YOUR DEVICE IN ENVIRONMENTS WHERE IT MAY BE DAMAGED

Water, beverage, and even food spills can harm your device.

6. DON'T LEAVE YOUR DEVICE IN THE CAR

If you have to, keep it out of sight or locked in the trunk.

7. DON'T USE YOUR DEVICE IN PUBLIC PLACES

Never use your device on the bus, at a bus stop or other public locations where a thief may see it.

8. PAY ATTENTION TO YOUR SURROUNDINGS.

Stay alert. Thieves target people that aren't paying attention.

9. ALWAYS RETURN YOUR DEVICE TO A TEACHER OR A SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR

If you are required to turn in your device, never leave it on a cart or on a teacher's desk. Always place it in the hands of a teacher or a school administrator.

10. IF YOU'RE THREATENED OR IN DANGER, GIVE IT UP

This is the most important tip of all - a device can be replaced, you can't!
