School district police officers are authorized to enforce all laws within the boundaries of the school district as well as on property outside of the district that is owned, leased, rented by or otherwise under the control of the district. We are well-trained professionals who work together as a team, adapt to changing environments, and reflect the values of the Mansfield Independent School District in carrying out our assignments.

We are committed to working in partnership with our schools, the community, and local law enforcement to provide a safe and secure environment for our students, staff, and the community.

Officers work 202 days a year receiving the same days off as students. These days include Thanksgiving break, Christmas/Winter break, and Spring Break. Officers may also receive up to 5 weeks off to use as vacation during the summer.

Officers work sporting events, dances, carnivals, graduations, proms, musicals, and any other event as determined by the Chief of Police. All overtime is paid in accordance with Federal Law.
