Other Considerations

- 1. A MISD athlete must have received a varsity letter and graduated from high school.
- 2. The award may be voted posthumously.
- 3. An outstanding athlete at MISD who has later led an exemplary life.
- 4. Attention should be given to candidate's body of work at MISD as an athlete, coach, administrative staff member, or distinguished volunteer.
- 5. Consideration can be given to a candidate who has achieved success at an elite or professional level (i.e.: Olympics, Pro)
- 6. The award will be presented during Hall of Honor banquet.
- 7. Candidates will not be considered until their MISD high school has been in existence for at least 10 years.
- 8. The nomination committee will submit the names of 10 finalists, each year, for consideration for the selection committee. The selection committee has the authority to accept as few or as many as they deem fit for the honor.
- 9. Once the selection committee makes their selections, any remaining finalists will automatically become finalists for the following 2 years. These finalist names will remain confidential. Once an individual has been nominated, he or she will continue to be considered for induction with subsequent MISD classes.
- 10. In addition to the official nomination form, the following materials should be submitted for an individual's consideration:
 - ❖ A letter of recommendation from the person making the nomination and/or other letter of support from appropriate individuals who can validate or substantiate pertinent information related to the high school career of the nominee
 - Any newspaper clippings, magazine articles, copies of scorebooks, school records, awards and statistics may be included to help substantiate the accomplishments and contributions of the nominee. Copies of the original items will be accepted but will not be returned.
