# Committee Recommendations

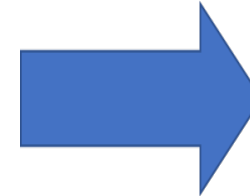
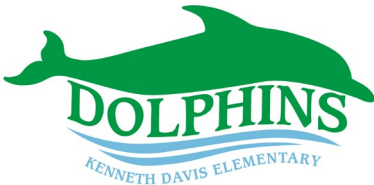
1. Want schools of choice/specialty programs in the area

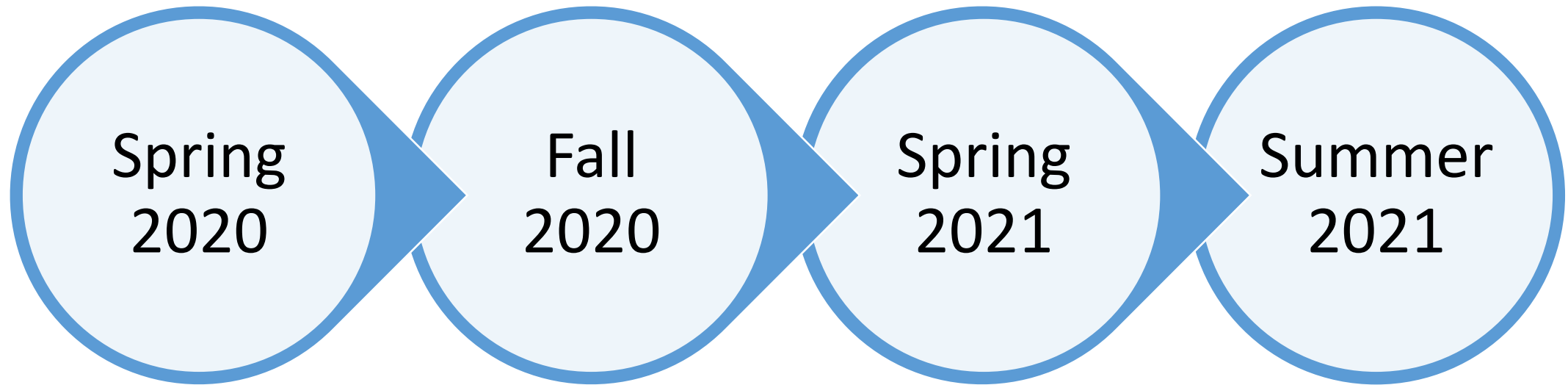
