## MISD Independent Study Requirements:

- 1. Independent Study Topic selection
  - a. Students will get a list of choices and have an opportunity to select a topic of personal interest
    - i. The topic choices come from the Texas Performance Standard
      Independent Study put out by TEA for advanced students, or from the
      Envision Program, which is designed for students not sufficiently
      challenged by grade-level curriculum. (Both of which include a
      Pursuit of Passion option.)
- 2. Students will complete the Student Agreement
- 3. Students will put forth their best effort at all times
- 4. Students will produce a quality level product and/or performance as a result of what is learned through the independent study research process.
- 5. The independent study product and/or performance development will happen during the school day. Students can always continue the learning process on their own time, if desired.
