ESSER III – American Rescue Plan

- Respond to the pandemic and the impact it has had on student learning
- 20% of the plan, \$5.0M, must be dedicated to Learning Loss We have spent \$4.6M and will meet the 20% requirement.
- Two plans required: Review every six months
 - Plan 1: Safe Return to In-Person Instruction and Continuity of Services Plan – No Changes
 - Plan 2: Use of Funds
