


MISD FINE ARTS PERFORMANCE EXPECTATIONS

Additionally, the Fine Arts Performance Expectations provides expectations with participation in District, Association, and UIL events (i.e., TAEA, TDEA, TETA, TMEA, ITS, etc.). The basis for these expectations, which have included the historic events that have improved programs and student outcomes for the MISD Fine Arts Department are not to limit teachers discretion; rather, it is intended to unify student experiences among campus levels.
